PRE-LICENSING CLASS INFORMATION ON LICENSING

- I. The Colorado Division of Insurance contracts with Pearson VUE to provide producer licensing examination and licensing services. All questions regarding testing and licensing should be directed to Pearson VUE at 800-275-8247. Pearson VUE will direct any questions to the Division should it require Division review. Division staff, however, does not perform licensing functions.

- III. You will be required to obtain a license after passing your exam. Information on the process will be provided to you in writing with your exam results. Further information can also be found in the Candidate Handbook.
- IV. Please note that your pre-licensing class attendance will only be valid for ONE YEAR. You must apply for a license within one year or you will be required to re-take the pre-licensing class. If you attempt to take the exam after ONE YEAR, you will not be licensed until you complete a pre-licensing class.

 - You will be able to obtain the date on which your license was issued, the lines of authority you have requested and the expiration date of your license.

- VIII. Colorado law requires that you change your address within 30 days of a change. This may be done at www.Sircon.com/Colorado Click Change Your Address. We also ask that you change your email address at the same location.
- IX. You are not required to fulfill the Continuing Education requirement until your first renewal. You can check you CE status at all times on www.Sircon.com/Colorado Check CE
